The male, later identified as the offender Deangelo Armstead, was lying on the bed within the room, he was asleep. Blood was located on the bed sheets and pillows around Deangelo. Deangelo was awoken and detained without incident. When Deangelo awoke, it was apparent he had been drinking alcohol and later confirmed he had consumed vodka. An empty vodka bottle laid on the floor nearby.</p> <p>The victim was taken outside of the complex and American Medical Response (AMR) arrived to give aid / assistance to the victim. Officers met with the victim as she was being treated and learned some additional information. She reported she and Deangelo had been in a relationship for some time and was hesitant to tell officers what occurred because she loved him. However, the victim admitted Deangelo was responsible for her injuries and had lost consciousness from the assault. She decided to call 9-1-1 after she awoke from being assaulted and saw herself / injuries in the bathroom mirror. She noted Deangelo had been upset about her son trying to keep Deangelo away from her, along with her residence in Chandler, Indiana, due to domestic violence. She also reported Deangelo was responsible for recently breaking her left arm, which was in a cast.</p> <p>Again, while speaking with the victim, it appeared she sustained significant trauma to her face, to include her orbital bones. AMR also acknowledged they believed she sustained significant facial injuries and needed to transport her as soon as possible. The victim was transported by AMR to St. Vincent Medical Center Emergency Room for additional treatment.</p> <p>Prior to being transported to the hospital, the EPD Crime Scene Unit arrived on scene and photographed the victim's injuries and the crime scene as it was found.</p> <p>Deangelo wore jeans and no shirt at the time he was detained. His jeans had blood on them, along with his hands. A gray sweatshirt laid on the floor and it also appeared to be stained with blood. As mentioned above, there was blood staining on the bed sheets, pillows and a towel. There was blood spatter and/or staining on the wall near the bed. No injuries were observed on Deangelo's person.</p> <p>Although the victim tried to protect Deangelo and requested not to pursue charges against her boyfriend, she had acknowledged he had assaulted her. Additionally, there was evidence of such an assault which is outlined above. Given the totality of the circumstances, the victim's statements and the corroborating evidence observed at the scene, officers had probable cause and a duty to arrest Deangelo Armstead for domestic battery resulting in serious bodily injury. At the very least, the victim sustained moderate bodily injury which is also a felony. Deangelo was arrested and booked into the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center.</p>		MORROW, H.
