Officers were dispatched to a theft in progress at the listed address. The reporter stated two males had entered the tow yard and had been stealing items out of vehicles in the lot. Upon arrival the reporter was standing in the parking lot outside the business and pointed out the offender to us, who was still in the lot. The offender was then placed into custody. More officers arrived in the area and extensively searched for the other male but were unable to locate him.

The reporter stated the offender we had in custody had previously been barred from the lot for a prior incident. The accomplice checked in at the front desk to look at vehicles that would be for sale on tomorrows date. The accomplice and the offender then entered the lot. The reporter at that time did not recognize the offender, because he was covering his face with a mask due to Covid-19.

The reporter then received a call from an additional customer on the lot, who told the reporter the males were taking stereos and other items out of the vehicles they had for sale. The reporter saw the males leaving the lot and confronted them at that time. The offender was in a black truck on the lot and his accomplice then ran south on Evans Ave before turning west on Tennessee St. Officers then arrived and placed the offender into custody. Pre Miranda the offender admitted without being questioned that he had taken a stereo deck, located in the bed of the truck, as well as a backpack, also located in the truck, from the for sale vehicles in the lot. The offender was also found to have 2 outstanding misdemeanor warrants out of Vanderburgh county. The stolen items were returned to tri state on scene. The offender only knew his accomplice as, "Juice" and thought his first name was Josh.

Upon inspection of three different vehicles on the lot, there was significant damage to the dash in each vehicle from the stereo's being removed. This damage was photographed via Bodyworn camera prior to officers leaving.

The offender was then transported to the VCJ and booked for the described charges.

IO stated that the victim suffers from extreme paranoia schizophrenia, with other mental illnesses, and the on call doctor confirmed the victim's and the suspect's mental illnesses. The doctor also recommended for both of those patients to stay in the facility and to continue their treatment due to their severity.

IO stated that the floor nurse, the WI, witnessed the incident. We were not able to call or reach the witness at the time of the report.

IO read me the witness's statement report about the incident, which stated that, the suspect and the victim were in the day room. WI wrote, that it was a lunch time, and the suspect got up from his table had his shirt on top of his head, and came towards the victim and punched him with a close fists multiple times. The WI wrote that the victim was out of consciousness for about 2 minutes at the time whenever he was trying to give him some help.

IO stated that the victim was transported to the hospital, and was discharged back to the facility. IO stated that the victim did not suffer any major injuries. He only had swollen lip, scratch marks, and bruise marks around his face.

I talked to the victim with the IO present. The victim stated that the suspect was about wodo magic, and was very scary. The victim stated that he suffered 20 years from this issues, and he was not happy how the suspect kept looking at him at the day room. The victim stated that they were seated at the separate tables about 6-7 feet apart, and the suspect was able to reach from that distance and punch him. The victim stated that he was not out of consciousness, and that he is hard headed. The victim stated that he could feel the punches, but he just closed his eyes.

I did not observe any major marks or scratches on the victims face. I was able to observe his swollen lip.

I was not able to talk to the suspect due to him being locked in a secure room and being extremely violent.

I gave a case number to the victim and advised him future steps.
