	<p>Page-Wade remained home. According to Duffy, Page-Wade became upset because he did not want her to leave and began battering her in the living room. Duffy advised Page-Wade pushed her down onto the couch. Duffy then tried to leave the residence, banging on the windows screaming for help when Page-Wade picked her up and slammed her on the ground. Duffy tried to run out the front door, but Page-Wade physically blocked her way out using his body, essentially confining her to the home. Eventually, Duffy was able to escape out the front door. Page-Wade followed behind her and pushed her onto the concrete ground, causing several physical injuries. Duffy advised she was able to leave the residence in her vehicle and called 911 at 2501 Menards Drive to report the assault. While on scene, we observed injuries (scratches and abrasions) to Duffy`s left hand, right hand, left knee, right knee, neck, and stomach. A Crime Scene detective was called to the scene to photograph Duffy`s injuries. Duffy did mention that she wanted to press charges. Duffy had mentioned that Page-Wade had her cell phone and had called management at the Burger King, explaining his intentions of returning it. We remained on scene for awhile, but Page-Wade never arrived. A manager at Burger King wished for us to bar/ban Page-Wade if we were able to make contact. We also advised Duffy of several resources to assist her heal through the domestic battery she faced.</p> <p>Approximately an hour and a half later, we received another 911 from Duffy at 2501 Menards Drive. Duffy advised Central Dispatch that Page-Wade was on scene and wanted EPD to come out and bar/ban him. I radioed over the air to responding officers that we had domestic battery charges on Page-Wade. Officer Staats arrived and told Page-Wade to place his hands behind his back. Page-Wade physically pulled his body away from officers and actively resisted being put into handcuffs. Officer Staats used force to handcuff Page-Wade, which was successful. Officer Staats suffered from bodily injury to his hands, which was later photographed by a Crime Scene detective. Page-Wade advised he was uninjured on scene. An EPD Sergeant was requested on scene for the use of force.</p> <p>While waiting for an EPD Sergeant to arrive, Officer Klein searched Page-Wade incident to arrest and located a green leafy substance contained in a plastic bag in Page-Wade`s right jacket pocket. Officer Klein recognized the substance to be marijuana based on his training and experience. Officer Klein then passed off the marijuana to Officer Staats, who secured the marijuana evidence in a separate plastic bag until I, Officer R. Eagleson, arrived on scene and took control of the evidence. An Officer on scene read the Miranda Warning to Page-Wade on scene, who claimed that he and Duffy live together. Page-Wade advised that Duffy had been punching out glass and mirrors at home, which is how she sustained injuries. Page-Wade even made the comment that he was a boxer and had he been the one to actually hit her, she would have looked much worse. Page-Wade, in addition to his charges, had an active warrant for his arrest. Page-Wade was transported to the Vanderburgh County Jail under the listed charges and his active warrant.</p> <p>At the Vanderburgh County Jail, I, Officer Eagleson, field tested the green leafy substance using the NARK II Duquenois Levine Reagent test kit #05. The green leafy substance field tested positive for the presence of THC. I then weighed the marijuana on a zeroed scale. The marijuana weighed 26 grams. The marijuana was properly bagged, sealed, and labeled according to department operational guidelines, then secured in the narcotics evidence storage locker at the Vanderburgh County Jail. Prior to booking Page-Wade, he admitted to getting into a physical altercation with Duffy at their residence as she [Duffy] originally reported. Page-Wade admitted to pulling her away from the window as she was tearing down the blinds. Page-Wade advised that she had tripped over a plastic</p>
