Officers were dispatched to 3511 Jackson Ave in reference to a Fight in Progress. On scene it was discovered the location of the altercation occurred at 3507 Jackson Ave. There was a language barrier on scene and gathering information was very difficult. One individual on scene was able to translate for the victims. She advised the offender came over to the apartment, was invited inside and an argument began over a picture. The picture apparently cost approximately \$300 and was torn in half during the altercation. Things became physical after the picture was torn and the offender grabbed a ceramic flower pot to use against the victims. Both victim's sustained minor cuts as a result. The offender left the scene on foot, walking to the east.

Once officers were able to gather the story, the victim's both just wanted the offender to be barred from the address and did not want to press charges or even report the incident. While waiting for medical assistance to arrive, victim # 2 began to have a diabetic episode. Fire was called to the scene and began tending to victim # 2 until AMR arrived. Both victim's were evaluated on scene by AMR for minor cuts from the incident, victim # 1 had a minor cut the back of the head and victim # 2 had a minor cut to the left elbow. Victim # 2 was transported to the hospital for further treatment as a result from the diabetic episode.

There were two other individuals on scene who were not involved in the altercation and they both refused to give any information to officers. Before AMR arrived on scene, victim # 1 changed her mind and wanted the offender to go to jail. The offender was said to be a family member, at one point being a sister and later being called a cousin. Detailed information about the offender could not be gathered and all officers were able to obtain was a possible name and that she was 30 years old. Additionally, the picture in question that supposedly started the incident was never brought up again by any of the involved and was not seen in the apartment by officers.
