Upon my arrival, I noticed a male fitting that exact description slumped over leaning on the isle. I approach the male and asked if I could pat him down for weapons. He stated I could. While checking for weapons I felt a pill bottle in his front left pocket. I asked if it could take it out. He took it out of his pocket. Without asking, the male opened the pill bottle and a green leafy substance was visible. I placed the male in handcuffs at this time.

I read the male the Miranda Warning. I asked him if he understood his rights. He stated he did.

I asked if the green leafy substance was Marijuana. He said it was. I asked if it was his. He stated it was. Under the Marijuana in the pill bottle there were three different kinds of pill and a piece of aluminum foil containing an uknown substance. The male stated it was a crushed pain pill. The pill bottle was labeled in his name and was for Buprenorphine Naloxone 8mg/2mg. One was a long green pill with S 90 3 inscribed on one side. The second pill was an orange circular pill with 54 475. The male stated that they were both forms of Xanax. The third pill was an orange oval pill with B705 on one side. Poison Control verified that the green pill was Xanax/Alprazolam 2mg. Poison Control stated the circular orange pill was Buprenorphine Naloxone 8mg/2mg. Drugs.Com stated the pill with B705 was also Alprazolam.

The male was cited and released. All evidence was transported to EPD Headquaters. The green leafy substance tested positive for Marijuana. I used a NARK-II testing kit to test the Marijuana. All evidence was properly bagged and labeled. Evidence was then stored in JTWL.
