He then received another email informing him that the transaction was fraudulent. The reporter had shipped five separate boxes of equipment by UPS. He was able to have four of the boxes returned to the business (victim) before delivery. One box had already been delivered to 1100 E Louisiana St in Evansville and he was not able to have it returned to the business (victim). The box of equipment was valued at approximately \$45,400. An Evansville Police Department detective was able to locate the package at 1100 E Louisiana St. 1100 E Louisiana St is a local warehouse/transportation company. Detectives spoke with the president and vice president of the warehouse and had them hold the package. The president of the warehouse stated that he had been contacted by a new customer prior to receiving the package. The warehouse president and employees had no knowledge of the fraudulent activities. The new customer was/is possibly the offender in the initial fraud. The president of the warehouse provided detectives with the new customer information. The information on the customer that had the package shipped to Evansville will be attached to this report. Detectives then made contact with the reporter and he made arrangements with UPS to have the package returned. At this time all of this report it appears that Evansville was used as a possible pivot point for the package and the fraudulent activity actually took place elsewhere.
