I stopped the vehicle in the parking lot of the McDonald's just north of the intersection. Upon speaking to the involved other, M. (the driver), I could smell the strong distinct odor of marijuana coming from the passenger compartment of the vehicle. After supporting units arrived, M and the offender, front seat passenger), were asked from the vehicle and advised the reasoning. I searched the vehicle and found under the front passenger seat an open Swisher Sweets cigar package. I looked inside the package and observed a hand rolled cigar that had greenish-brown leafy substance on the end and the odor of marijuana coming from it.
