At the hospital the male was read implied consent and stated that he understood implied consent and would agree to a blood draw from a State Kit. This was completed by nursing staff at the hospital and the blood vials were properly labeled and sealed in the kit. The male was then transported to the jail.

At the jail, the green leafy substance was weighed and tested. The approximate weight was 3.00 Grams and it achieved a positive result for Synthetic Cannabinoids. The substance was then sealed in an evidence bag and stored in the drop box at the jail.

The male was then booked on the described charges.

Officers were dispatched to 201 N. Congress in reference to a possible overdose. The caller advised that the OF was unconscious and having difficulty breathing. The OF was in side a black Chevy Tahoe. Officers and EFD arrived on scene, where I observed the OF lying on the ground, beside the driver's seat. Citizens had already pulled the OF out and laid him on the ground, to help with his breathing. EFD quickly gave the OF a dose of Narcan and a few seconds later, the OF came to.

Off. E. Slayton observed three or four brownish rocks sitting on the center console, as well as a syringe in plain view. Due to the nature of the call and Off. Slayton's training and experience, Off. Slayton believed the rocks to be Heroin. During the inventory search, Off. Slayton located another syringe, near the gear shift, under the radio. Det. K. Montgomery also arrived to assist with the investigation. Det. Montgomery collected the suspected narcotics and both syringes.

Officers then called Tristate for a tow. When the tow truck driver climbed in the driver's seat, he felt a hard object under his buttocks, hidden in the seat fabric. Through a rip in the seat, he could see it was a multi-clored glass pipe. The driver alerted me and retrieved the glass pipe from the driver's seat. The pipe did contain burnt material and markings in the bowl, which indicated that the OF was ingesting narcotics via the glass pipe.

The OF was then taken to Deaconess Midtown for treatment, via AMR. Due to the OF's condition, he was not arrested on site. Charges are being filed and a warrant will need to be issued for his arrest. Det. Montgomery later tested the suspected heroin and it did test positive for Fentanyl Heroin and had a field weight of .25 grms. Det. Montgomery and I met later, where I then gave her the glass pipe.
