<p><i>Operating A Vehicle While Intoxicated</i></p>	<p>03/27/2021. Reported: 03/27/2021.</p> <p>I, Officer R. Eagleson, along with my partner Officer R. Jones, were dispatched to 300 S Green River Road in regard to an intoxicated driver. We were fully dressed in Evansville Police Department uniforms and patrolling in fully marked Evansville Police Department vehicle 1744. The unknown reporter advised that a female at the pump is intoxicated and not wearing a shirt. The reporter advised it was a white Cube with a Kentucky license plate. The reporter advised that he witnessed the driver hit the curb at the grocery store and then hit the curb on her way in the gas station. He further advised that one of the vehicle's tires were on the rim and even asked the reporter to put air in the tire. He lastly stated that the driver was a white female with blonde hair.</p> <p>Officer A. Beaver arrived on scene, located the vehicle (a white 2010 Nissan Cube; Kentucky license plate: AHC757) in the parking lot parked next to a gas pump. Officer Beaver detained the driver, later identified as Jessica Smith. When Officer Jones and I arrived on scene, Officer Beaver mentioned that there was a passenger in the front seat. Officer Jones and I spoke to the passenger, identified as Lauren Titzer. Titzer advised that she and Jessica were on her way from her house on Marshall to work at The Pony. Titzer advised that they had both been drinking. Titzer mentioned that Jessica had several shots of tequila prior to driving and advised Jessica was in fact the driver. In plain view, I noticed several containers of alcohol that had been opened and consumed. The vehicle was later towed from the scene. Officer Jones observed damage to the front right of Jessica's vehicle (which was photographed using my department-issued body-worn camera). Several of the open bottles of alcohol were removed from the vehicle, photographed using my department-issued body-worn camera, and disposed of. Titzer's information was gathered and she was released on scene.</p> <p>I made contact with the driver, Jessica, and read her the Miranda Warning. Jessica advised she understood her rights and agreed to speak with me. While I was speaking with Jessica, I noticed that her speech was slurred and her eyes were red and glassy. Jessica advised that she consumed alcohol at approximately 1400 on today's date in the amount of 1 1/2 beers. Jessica denied any further drinking. Jessica did admit to driving the vehicle, however, but simply denied drinking while driving. I advised Jessica that I wanted her to perform some standardized field sobriety tests (SFSTs) so I knew if she was safe to drive. Jessica agreed to perform the SFSTs. Jessica was unhandcuffed at this time to perform the SFSTs.</p> <p>HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS</p> <p>I informed Jessica that I was going to check her eyes and asked her if she had any health problems or conditions that affected her eyes. She advised she did not. I asked her if there were any lights that were bothering her eyes. She advised that there were not. I had her stand with her feet together and her arms down by her side. I told her to stay in this position until told to do otherwise. She advised she understood. I explained the test to her, which she advised she understood. I noticed equal pupil sizes and equal tracking during my first two passes. On my second two passes, I checked for lack of smooth pursuit. I noticed nystagmus in both eyes (2 clues). On my third two passes, I checked for distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation. I noticed nystagmus in both eyes (2 clues). I lastly checked for onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees on my final two passes. I noticed nystagmus in both eyes (2 clues). The total clue count for the test was 6. 4 clues present is considered a failure of the test. Jessica failed the test.</p>

She advised it was. I asked her again if she had anything wrong with her balance or anything that would affect it. She advised there was not. I explained to Jessica the starting position: left foot on the line, right foot in front heel-to-toe, with her arms down by her side. I advised that she needed to hold that position until I finished explaining the test. She advised she understood. Almost immediately after explaining her the starting position, Jessica both started the test too soon (1 clue) and could not balance during the instructions to the point where she could not even stand in the starting position. The total clue count for the test was 5. 2 clues present is considered a failure for the test. Jessica failed the test.</p> <p>ONE LEG STAND</p> <p>I then had Jessica stand with her feet together and arms down by her side as I explained the one leg stand. Jessica advised she understood the test. I told her to begin. During the test, Jessica swayed (1 clue), used her arms for balance (1 clue), hopped (1 clue), and put her foot down (1 clue). The total clue count for the test was 4. 2 clues present is considered a failure for the test. Jessica failed the test.</p> <p>After the SFSTs, I developed probable cause that Jessica had been driving a motor vehicle while intoxicated. Officer Jones detained her into handcuffs. I had Jessica blow into a portable breath test (PBT), which measured her on-scene BrAC at .234. Jessica was transported to the Vanderburgh County Jail. At the Vanderburgh County Jail, I read Jessica Implied Consent. Jessica consented to a chemical test. I, Officer R. Eagleson, am an Indiana state certified Intoxilizer operator. Using certified Intoxilizer 011179, I performed a chemical test on Jessica. The chemical test results showed that Jessica's BrAC was .244 grams per 210 liters of breath, which is over three times the legal limit.
