Since Officer Aghasaryan was unsure who was who in the situation, he pointed toward the driveway of 5950 E Oak Street and told Gary to go over there. Gary did not listen and continued to approach Officer Aghasaryan. Officer Aghasaryan repeatedly tried to prevent Gary from entering his scene for his safety, but Gary did not listen and continued coming closer. Officer Aghasaryan developed probable cause that Gary was refusing to leave an emergency scene and attempted to take him into custody using handcuffs. During this time, Gary forcibly pulled away from Officer Aghasaryan. Officer Aghasaryan told Gary multiple times to "stop resisting" and even mentioned that he was trying to be gentle with him. Officer Aghasaryan was able to overpower Gary and place him into handcuffs. After Officer Aghasaryan placed Gary into handcuffs, he realized that his fingers had been cut as a result of Gary resisting him.</p> <p>I arrived on scene shortly after Gary was placed into custody. I talked with the involved parties, Albert and Janeicia. They advised that they purchased a lawn mower from Jeffrey Lindall, who lives at 5950 E Oak Street. They rented a truck from Home Depot and came to the residence in order to pick up the lawn mower. They decided to back into the yard in order to get closer to the lawn mower to make picking it up and placing it into the truck easier. When they backed into the yard, they realized that the truck's rear tires had sunk into the soft grass and mud. As a result, the truck got stuck. Unknown to Albert and Janeicia, they had actually backed into the property owned by Gary Hudson (5949 Knight Street), as it shares an open property border line with 5950 E Oak Street. They advised that Gary came out of his house and began yelling at them. They further advised that Gary escalated the issue by stealing the key to the lawn mower they had purchased and slapping Janeicia in the face. Albert even said that Gary tried to pull Janeicia out of the truck and tried to steal the truck keys. I asked Janeicia if she was injured. She advised she was not.
