The caller and victim, identified as Jon-Alec House, advised that he had assaulted his neighbor`s son Allen Thompson (offender) because he [Thompson] was on his [House`s] property. House advised that Thompson was on meth and currently back at his house at 515 S Congress Avenue.</p> <p>Upon arriving, I observed a white male in the driveway (later identified as Jon-Alec House) yelling at a subject who was walking around on the property of 515 S Congress Avenue, later identified as Thompson. I called for another unit for back up and began speaking with House. House advised that Thompson`s parents were over at his property (511 S Congress), but they were invited. House mentioned at some point, Thompson walked onto his [House`s] property. House asked Thompson to leave the property because he was not invited over. According to House, Thompson refused to leave the property. House advised he then began fighting with Thompson on the north-end of his property. The fight led into the driveway, which is a U-shaped drive that is shared by a few homes on the street.</p> <p>House advised during the fight, he dropped a carton of cigarettes. House advised he thought Thompson took them at this time. House said at some point during the fight, Thompson ran into his residence, armed himself with a metal bar, and ran back at him while he was standing in the driveway. House advised Thompson then swung the bar at him. House advised that Thompson missed hitting him. In the middle of swinging the bar, Thompson let go of it and it landed in the yard. While I was speaking with House, I observed Thompson walking around with a metal bar in his hands, which he eventually put down on a small table located on the patio of 515 S Congress Avenue. I told House to wait inside while I spoke with Thompson.</p> <p>At this point, Officer Hadley arrived to assist. I filled in Officer Hadley on what House had told me and what I observed when I arrived. I advised Officer Hadley that I was going to speak with Thompson. We walked over to 515 S Congress Avenue and spoke with Thompson. Since I believed there was criminal activity afoot and had reason to believe that Thompson was armed and dangerous, I patted him down for weapons. During my pat down, I asked Thompson if it was okay if I searched his pockets. He allowed me to search his pockets. In his right front pants pocket I located a package of cigarettes. I put the cigarettes on the ground at this time. I also located a lighter, which I placed on the ground and out of reach for safety.</p> <p>After my pat down, I began speaking with Thompson. I had Thompson sit back down on his patio and asked him what had happened. Thompson advised that he went onto House`s property to check on his mother. Thompson advised that House became angry, began "talking shit," and told him that he was trespassing. Thompson advised that an argument ensued, which escalated all the way to his porch at 515 S Congress. Thompson said he told House, "keep coming, I got something for you."
