Officers initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle at Jackson/Bedford.</p> <p>The front seat passenger of the vehicle began to exit, but complied when ordered back into the vehicle. Officers made contact with the occupants of the vehicle and discovered the back seat passenger had an active felony warrant. The passenger was placed in custody.</p> <p>Officers continued talking to the female in the front seat who was shaking and visibly nervous. The female stated she tried to get out because she was going to a known friends house, but was unable to provide the name or address of the friend. The female also attempted to inhale from an unlit cigarette, and did not realize the cigarette was lit. Officers asked the female why she was so nervous, and she stated she didn't want to get in trouble. Officers asked the female to exit the vehicle and asked if she had anything illegal on her and she stated no. Officers conducted a pat down of the female for safety. During the pat down, officers felt a hard, cylinder shaped object. Officers asked the female if we could search her pocket to retrieve the item after she stated she did not know what it was, and she stated yes. Officers located a vape pen and an extra cartridge, that through training and experience was suspected of being a THC vape. Officers asked the female if the vape contained THC and she stated yes.</p> <p>The female was placed in handcuffs at the time and detained. During a search incident to arrest of the female's purse, a second extra cartridge labeled as "1 gram" of THC was located. The cartridges all contained a yellow colored, sticky liquid that field tested positive for THC. The cartridges were seized as evidence.</p> <p>The female was issued a citation for possession of THC and released from the scene.
