I, Officer R. Eagleson, was dispatched to 401 N Burkhardt Road in regard to a shoplifter who had been detained by Walmart loss prevention. Upon arriving, I was met by the reporter, who works for loss prevention. The reporter advised that the offender had stolen merchandise from the store. The reporter also had two other subjects detained for shoplifting in another room. He advised he would be back to explain what happened after handling the other incident. He made quick mention that the offender took the barcodes off of cheaper items in the store and then taped them onto her merchandise, erroneously lowering the price of the merchandise at checkout.

I placed the offender into handcuffs. I asked the offender if I could search her. The offender consented to a search. During my search, I located a glass pipe containing burnt residue in her left leg cargo pocket. Based on my training and experience, I knew the pipe was drug paraphernalia used to ingest illegal narcotics into the body. I seized the pipe, finished searching the offender, and had her sit down. During the rest of my search, I located a dog leash in her front hoodie pocket that was stolen from Walmart.

I read the offender the Miranda Warning. I asked the offender if she understood her rights and if she would speak to me. The offender advised that she understood her rights and agreed to speak to me about the incident. I asked her if she stole items today from Walmart. The offender admitted that she did steal the items. I looked at the receipts of the stolen items, which totaled to \$318.73 before adding taxes. She admitted to taping false barcodes from the store onto the merchandise she had in her possession in order to make it cheaper at checkout. She also admitted that she walked out of the store with the stolen merchandise until she was stopped by the reporter in the vestibule. The offender advised that the reporter told her why he was stopping her and identified himself as Walmart loss prevention.

The reporter returned to the room and explained what happened. The reporter mentioned that he observed the offender in the store removing tags/barcodes from merchandise, then taping them over the barcodes of the merchandise that she selected. The reporter advised that the offender went to self checkout #29, scanned the incorrect barcodes affixed onto the items, rendered payment for the mislabeled items, passed all points of purchase, and then exited the store through the grocery entrance/exit.

The offender was cited for shoplifting and for possessing paraphernalia. The offender was also barred/banned from all Walmart properties for life and then
