I asked her if she stole items today from Walmart. The offender admitted that she did steal the items. I looked at the receipts of the stolen items, which totaled to \$318.73 before adding taxes. She admitted to taping false barcodes from the store onto the merchandise she had in her possession in order to make it cheaper at checkout. She also admitted that she walked out of the store with the stolen merchandise until she was stopped by the reporter in the vestibule.
