We observed a silver colored Honda CR-V (license plate: YBI702) traveling south-bound on Cullen Avenue approaching the three way stop at Bellemeade Avenue. The Honda failed to stop for the stop sign at the three-way stop, and then turned west-bound on Bellemeade Avenue. I activated the emergency lights of the patrol vehicle behind the Honda. The Honda turned south-bound on Hoosier Avenue and stopped to the side of the road. We approached the vehicle and I immediately smelled the odor of burnt marijuana emanating from the passenger compartment. I had the driver, identified as the offender, exit the vehicle and asked her if there was anything in the vehicle she was not supposed to have. The offender told me that she had some marijuana in the center-console. The offender was taken to the rear of her vehicle and placed into handcuffs by Officer Eagleson.<br><br>I proceeded to search the vehicle and found a small amount of green leafy substance that, based on my training and experience, I believed to be marijuana in the center console, a metal pipe with residue in the center console, a multicolored glass pipe with residue underneath the driver`s seat, and a second multicolored glass pipe with residue in the seat-pocket of the passenger seat. The offender was cited for disregarding a stop sign, possession of marijuana, and possession of paraphernalia and released on scene. The green-leafy substance was weighed using a digital scale, with the weight being .1 gram. The green-leafy substance was tested using a Duquenois-Levine Reagent Kit 05 and tested positive for marijuana. I proceeded to properly bag and label the items seized.
