Society VICTIM of Controlled Substance- Manufacture/dealing Methamphetamine (C), at 698 S Us Hwy 41/bellemeade Ave, Evansville, IN, between 02:00, 04/23/2021 and 02:30, 04/23/2021. Reported: 04/23/2021.

Officers were on routine patrol in the area of US Highway 41 and Riverside. Officers were behind a white Pontiac Grand Prix that was driving north in the left hand lane from Riverside to Bellemeade, without making a left hand turn. Officers conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle for a left lane violation at Highway 41 and Bellemeade Ave.

Officers approached the vehicle and could see drug paraphernalia in plain view in the vehicle. Officers called for additional units to assist, and then had the occupants of the vehicle exit the car. Officer had Offender 3 exit the vehicle, at which time he reached into his right pocket and threw a pill bottle into the seat. Officers conducted a search incident to arrest of Offender 3 and found two syringes in his back left pocket along with a smoking device with burnt residue. Officers also found multiple clear plastic sandwich bags in Offender 3's pockets.

Officers then had the other occupants exit the vehicle. Officers spoke with the owner of the vehicle, Offender 2, who stated that she did not know Offender 3 had the paraphernalia items or syringes with him. Offender 2 stated that there was nothing illegal in the vehicle and told officers that they could search the vehicle.

During a search of the vehicle, multiple additional paraphernalia items were located where Offender 3 was sitting. Officers also retrieved the pill bottle that Offender 3 attempted to throw out of his pocket, which contained a green leafy substance that the Offender later admitted was marijuana. Officers located a black back pack in the back floor board on the passenger's side. Officers located more clear plastic sandwich bags in the backpack, which Offender 1 stated was his backpack. Officers then popped the hood of the vehicle and immediately saw a purple pouch in the engine compartment on the driver's side. Officers opened the pouch and saw multiple syringes inside a plastic bag. Underneath the purple pouch, was a magnetic black box, and a scale with green leafy residue and white crystalline residue on it. Officers then opened the magnetic box and located a clear plastic bag containing a white crystalline substance and a second clear plastic bag containing a green leafy substance.

Officers placed all the occupants of the vehicle in handcuffs and read them their Miranda Rights. Offender 1 and 3 both stated that the items in the engine compartment belonged to the other. Offender 1 stated that he was simply doing Offender 2 and 3 a favor and driving them around because Offender 2 did not have a license. Offender 1 stated that he was asked by Offender 2 to give Offender 3 a ride and take him to a couple of friends` houses. Offender 1 stated that he did know the narcotics were in the engine compartment because he saw Offender 3 get some out at a house on Riverside Dr and then take narcotics into the house to sell. Offender 2 stated that she observed Offender 1 place the boxes into the engine compartment, and that he was the one who sold narcotics at the house on Riverside Dr.

All three of the subjects were arrested and charged with dealing methamphetamine, dealing schedule I, II, III, IV, and possession of a syringe.
