I pursued Sanders with my emergency equipment still activated for two blocks until she finally stopped at Garvin/Indiana Street.</p> <p>I approached Sanders and she advised me that she had been following her boyfriend in the blue SUV after an argument they had. She acknowledged that her actions were reckless and dangerous. Further, Sanders advised me that she did not have insurance on the vehicle. Sanders stated that she had just purchased the vehicle and gave me the title to the vehicle that had not been signed by her(ONLY THE SELLER SIGNED IT). Sanders also did not have a valid driver`s license, per her driver`s status check. Sanders has had a license at one time, but is now just listed to have an ID card only.</p> <p>Sanders had three active warrants for her arrest. She was arrested when she advised me that she had been exposed to COVID-19. Due to this, I did not inventory her vehicle for tow for obvious safety reasons. I left Sanders purse in the vehicle and advised assisting officers of the circumstances and to have Tristate winch the vehicle up onto the bed to minimize exposure to the driver.</p> <p>At the jail, Sanders advised Officer Brandenstein that she had a fever earlier this morning.
