"On today's date, Central Dispatch put out a BOL in reference to a white SUV aggressively following a blue vehicle in the area of Virginia and Garvin Street. I was in the area and observed the two vehicles immerge from the intersection South on Governor from Virginia. The White SUV was driving erratically and was following the caller in the blue SUV way too close. It appeared to me that the white SUV ran the red light at Governor/Franklin Street to continue following the caller. At this time I activated my lights and sirens, but was still approximately three blocks away from the two vehicles. The caller in the blue SUV turned West on an off street with the white SUV following dangerously close behind. Soon, the vehicles then emerged again with the white vehicle still following the caller in the blue SUV this time North on Governor, which was the wrong way on the one way street. This time, I was close enough that both vehicles could see/hear my lights/sirens. The caller in the blue SUV stopped and flashed his lights at me, while the driver in the white SUV, later identified as Felicia F. Sanders, quickly turned off Eastbound onto Indiana Street. I pursued Sanders with my emergency equipment still activated for two blocks until she finally stopped at Garvin/Indiana Street.

I approached Sanders and she advised me that she had been following her boyfriend in the blue SUV after an argument they had. She acknowledged that her actions were reckless and dangerous. Further, Sanders advised me that she did not have insurance on the vehicle. Sanders stated that she had just purchased the vehicle and gave me the title to the vehicle that had not been signed by her(ONLY THE SELLER SIGNED IT). Sanders also did not have a valid driver's license, per her driver's status check. Sanders has had a license at one time, but is now just listed to have an ID card only.

Sanders had three active warrants for her arrest. She was arrested when she advised me that she had been exposed to COVID-19. Due to this, I did not inventory her vehicle for tow for obvious safety reasons. I left Sanders purse in the vehicle and advised assisting officers of the circumstances and to have Tristate winch the vehicle up onto the bed to minimize exposure to the driver.

At the jail, Sanders advised Officer Brandenstein that she had a fever earlier this morning. The State of Indiana is still under a State of Emergency due to the COVID-19 Pandemic until July 31, 2020 per the State's website.

Sanders was booked on the listed charges as well as the three outstanding warrants for her arrest. Her vehicle was impounded."

The VI was the driver of the blue SUV mentioned above.

On today's date, the VI reported that he saw the OF on his property at about 0900 this morning. OF states that he has posted No Trespassing signs, and the OF knows she is not welcome on his property. He stated that she was hollering and cursing and left, but returned again at 1030 hours. VI was advised to take photos of the No Tresspass signs, and pursue charges through the Prosecutor's Office. I also encouraged him to apply for a Protective Order with the courts.
