Eagleson, were dressed in full Evansville Police Department uniform and patrolling in marked police unit 1744. We were dispatched to assist Officer Aghasaryan on a harassment in progress. Officer Aghasaryan informed officers that the suspect, Blake Rhodes, was possibly in the area of Shoe Carnival, (805 N. Green River Road). The reporter, Laurie Shaffer, told dispatch that Blake was walking in the area of the reporter's apartment complex waiting for her to come home. Laurie Schaffer has an active protective order against Blake Rhodes. Blake was described as a white male, wearing an unknown colored shirt and camouflage pants. Officer Aghasaryan also told the officers dispatched to the harassment in progress that Blake had two active felony warrants. I and Officer R. Eagleson arrived in the area at 1933 and saw a white male in camouflage pants wearing a black hooded sweat shirt and a back pack matching the description given by Officer Aghasaryan walking behind Jason's Deli, which is located at 943 N. Green River Road. We confirmed the male as Blake Rhodes by looking at his photo in RMS.</p> <p>When myself and Officer Eagleson approached Blake in our marked patrol unit, Officer Eagleson engaged the marked patrol unit's red and blue emergency lights. Both myself and Officer Eagleson immediately exited the vehicle and Officer Eagleson proceeded to give Blake clear verbal commands to stop and show us his hands. Both myself and Officer Eagleson approached Blake with our firearms drawn. Blake continued to blade his stance, make multiple hand movements in and around the waistband of his pants and walked away from both myself and Officer Eagleson. Blake continued to not comply with the clear verbal commands given by Officer Eagleson. Officer Eagleson proceeded to holster his firearm and draw his CEW. Officer Eagleson proceeded to deploy his CEW after Blake refused to comply with multiple orders to show officers his hands and we proceeded to place Blake in handcuffs. I proceeded to pull Blake's hand and arm from under his body in an attempt to place him in handcuffs. While attempting to place Blake in handcuffs, he was given multiple orders to stop reaching for his waistband. During this time I suffered an abrasion on my knuckles while Blake was resisting my effort to gain control of his arm and hand. The abrasion was later photographed with Officer Eagleson's department issued body-worn camera.</p> <p>After Blake was placed into handcuffs, Officer Eagleson searched him search incident to arrest. On Blake's person was a strapped nylon pouch containing an orange prescription-type bottle with a small baggie of white crystal-like substance located inside the bottle. The white crystal-like substance was later weighed and was tested for methamphetamine by means of a Nark II methamphetamine/ MDMA #15 reagent test kit administered by Officer Eagleson. The white crystal-like substance tested positive for methamphetamine and the field weight of the substance was 0.5 grams.
