We, Officer R. Jones and Officer R. Eagleson were dressed in full Evansville Police Department uniform and patrolling in Evansville Police Department vehicle 1744, were dispatched to a check-welfare run at 925 S. Green River Road. 925 S. Green River Road is a Walgreens Pharmacy. The notes provided to us in the dispatch run-card stated that the reporter (later identified as Stephanie Underhill) says she saw two females (later identified as Jessica Russell and Caswell) who were "Obviously on meth." The run-card stated that Stephanie described the two females as "One white female wearing all black with blond hair" and "One white female with blonde/ brown hair, wearing jeans with paint splatter on them." Stephanie also told Central Dispatch that the two females were "Going through things in the aisles" and were "Clearly strung out." We arrived at 1854 and met with the Stephanie who stated that the two females described in the run-card were still in the store. We entered the store and saw two females who matched the description standing in the check-out line at the front of the store. One of the females, later identified as Jessica Russell, was moving her arms in an erratic manner. By my training and experience, one female (later identified as Jessica Russell) appeared to be intoxicated in some way. We decided to wait for the two females outside of the Walgreens' entrance as to avoid an altercation in the store.

The two females exited the store we asked for their ID's and asked if we could pat them down. The two females consented to the pat-down and provided us with their ID's. We identified the two females as Jessica Russell and Caswell. I proceeded to pat down Caswell and Russell for weapons. We explained to Russell and Caswell that the reason we were dispatched to 925 S. Green River Road was due to a complaint that they may be intoxicated. Russell admitted to Officer Eagleson that she used to be an addict. Officer Eagleson asked Russell if he could check her wallet to "Make sure there are no drugs in it", to which Russell replied "Yeah that's fine." Officer Eagleson searched Russell's wallet and found a clear plastic bag with a crystal-like substance in it. Based on his training and experience, he believed the substance was methamphetamine. Officer Eagleson proceeded to detain Russell using handcuffs and search her prior to arrest. Russell was transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center at 1932. Caswell was released on scene after learning she did not commit a crime.

At the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center, Officer Eagleson weighed the crystal-like substance found in Russell's wallet on a triple-bean scale. The field weight of the substance was 22 grams. Officer Eagleson field-tested the substance using a Nark II Methamphetamine/MDMA Reagent Kit #15. The substance tested positive for methamphetamine. Officer Eagleson proceeded to properly bag, label, and seal the methamphetamine in an evidence bag. The methamphetamine was then placed into evidence at the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center in the narcotics evidence locker. Russell was booked in on the listed charges.
