Officers spoke with the mother, Kimberly Glaser, who stated that her daughter, Starr Fauguher, showed up at her house without any invitation and began causing a scene. She stated that Fauquher was banging on the door and screaming into the open window, calling her multiple different names. She stated that she did at one point throw most of the mail, except the disputed checks, out of the door. She stated that as she was standing at the screen door her daughter continued yelling and calling her names over the checks. Glaser stated that Fauquher was kicking the front screen door repeatedly and she eventually opened the door to confront her. She stated that Fauquher squared up to her and balled up her fists, and then she smacked her once. She stated her son arrived soon after and convinced her to go inside and just give over the disputed checks.
