Officers initiated a traffic stop, and made contact with the passenger, Triston Smith. As Officers were speaking with Smith they observed in plain view on the dashboard a green leafy substance, which based upon their training and experience they immediately recognized as marijuana. Officers then asked Smith to exit the vehicle and asked him when was the last time he had smoked marijuana. Smith stated that he had just smoked 20 minutes ago, and that the green leafy substance on the dashboard belonged to him. Smith was cited for possession of marijuana and was released from the scene. The driver was given a verbal warning for no plate light.</p> <p>While at the jail in relation to a different traffic stop, Officers weighed the green leafy substance on a zeroed digital scale, and it produced a field weight of 1.2 grams. Officers then tested the green leafy substance using the NARK II Duquenois-Levine Reagent test kit #5, which yielded a positive result for THC. Officer Shahine located a bag in the back seat. Inside the bag contained a clear baggie with a green plant like substance. Inside this clear baggie was another clear baggie with 10 yellow pills with the imprint "K7". These pills were identified as Cyclobenzaprine Hydrochloride 10 mg. This is a prescription only medication. There were 2 alcohol bottles located in the bag along that belonged to JM. These items were located in the back seat where JM told officers he was previously sitting. MG and JM were placed into handcuffs behind their back. One partial liquor bottle was located under the driver's seat. MT was given a phone so she could contact her mother to come to our location.</p> <p>I read MT and JM Miranda Rights and they both said they understood. I informed MT that she had to right to talk to a parent as well. Officer Stepro read MG Miranda Rights. JM and MT both told me that they got the sleeping pills from MT's dad MG. MG admitted to Officer Shahine that he gave the pills to JM. JM and MT openly told me they both smoke marijuana and had earlier in the day. I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from JM's breathe when speaking to him. JM admitted to drinking alcohol.</p> <p>MT's mother was called to the scene and she was released to her mom.</p> <p>MG and JM were transported to the Vanderburgh County Jail by the transport wagon. Once at the jail, the green plant like substance tested positive for marijuana with a weight of 4.2g. All evidence was placed into evidence bags and sealed.
