Reported: 05/29/2021.</p> <p>On 5/29/21 at approximately 0236, officers were in the area of Franklin and Fulton. I noticed a female lying on the ground on Franklin. I stopped my vehicle and activated my emergency lights. The female stated she was in an argument and the male had thrown her keys into the storm drain and she was looking for them.</p> <p>A male, offender James Moore, started walking South on Fulton towards our location. I asked the male if he had her keys and he said no. The male's speech was extremely slurred. I could tell the male was extremely intoxicated. The male took off his shirt and began to flex his muscles. The male identified himself as James Moore. While talking to James about the keys he pulled his pants down. I told James to pull up his pants. James started to become aggressive in his posture and voice. James stated "What the fuck you mean." James started walking towards me and I told him to step back. As officer Rasche began to walk to where I was standing, James became even more aggressive by flexing his muscles, throwing his shirt, and stated "you walking up on me." James stated he had been drinking. James called officers a bitch and grabbed his groin area and said suck these nuts. James was told he could leave, but he refused.</p> <p>James walked up to Officer Rasche and came within 2 feet. James then walked up on me and got within 2 feet. I pushed James back and told him not to walk up on me. As I was doing this, James pushed my arm away. I told James several times to walk away or he was going to go to jail. James continued to argue with officers and yell. I told James I was done and to put his hands behind his back as I started to walk towards him. James took off running from Officers. Officer Wiseman and Officers Oxford were standing close and were able to grab James as he ran away and they all went to the ground. James was told to put his hands behind his back and continued to resist by pulling away and stiffening so officers could not place him in handcuffs. I grabbed James's right arm and placed it behind his back. Officer Rasche put handcuffs on James behind his back.</p> <p>While James was on the ground, he continued to roll away and failed to cooperate with officers. Officers had to hold James to the ground with his legs crossed and pressure on his left arm. I called for a supervisor for use of force. James made threats to officers that if we took the cuffs off him he would show us. Later, James told me to take the cuffs off of him and he would whoop all our asses.</p> <p>James calmed down and was sat up. The transport wagon arrived and I started to escort James to the wagon. James pulled away from me and was pinned against the wagon. James was transported to the Vanderburgh Co. Jail.</p> <p>Once at the jail, I opened the wagon doors to get James out and he refused to come out. I grabbed James and helped him out of the wagon.
