The offenders were taken into custody without incident and escorted out of the residence out of view of the juvenile. Officers read both offenders the Miranda Rights Warning to which they both stated they understood. Both offenders admitted to ingesting a mixture of Methamphetamine and Heroin using a syringe. Officers read both offenders, whom both claimed to live at the dispatched address and live/sleep in the rear bedroom, the Pirtle Rights Warning. Both offenders consented to officers searching the bedroom and seizing all narcotic`s and equipment used to ingest the suspected narcotics. Officers conducted the search and located several hypodermic syringe`s, narcotic paraphernalia, and Schedule V controlled substances in a pill bottle prescribed to another individual. DCS was contacted and this incident was reported regarding the neglect and endangerment to the juvenile. One of the syringe`s had one of the offenders blood, suggesting it had been recently used.
