Officers advised Cooper that we could see a roach in the ashtray and asked what was in it. Cooper stated the roach contained Marijuana. Cooper also stated that there was more marijuana located in the center console of the vehicle.</p> <p>Officers searched the vehicle and found the stash of marijuana. Officers asked Cooper if he drove himself to his current location and he stated that he did. Zeigler admitted that everything inside of the vehicle was his. All items of evidence were properly bagged, labeled, and placed into evidence at EPD Headquarters.
