over the retaining wall and got stuck. I identified the driver as Joseph. Joseph was the only occupant in the vehicle.

I walked back outside and began speaking with Joseph. I asked Joseph if he would perform some test for me and he said yes. I walked Joseph to an asphalt paved parking lot that was level and smooth. I asked Joseph if the ground was flat and level and he said yes. I asked Joseph if he had any surgeries or problems with his legs and he said his foot was sore.

I administered Standardized Field Sobriety Test. The first test given was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. Joseph had equal pupils and equal tracking in both eyes. During this test, I observed the following clues; lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and nystagmus onset prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. I observed a total of 6 clues.

The second test given was the Walk and Turn. I explained to Joseph how I wanted him to stand while I explained the instructions and he said he understood. While explaining the rest of the instructions, Joseph broke heal to toe and could not keep balance. During the walking phase, Joseph missed heal to toe, raised arms for balance, stepped off line, turns improperly, and took wrong amount of steps. I observed a total 6 clues.

The third test given was the One Leg Stand. I explained the instructions to Joseph and he said he understood. During this test, I observed the following clues; raised arms for balance, put foot down multiple times, and swayed. I observed a total of 3 clues.

I placed Joseph in handcuffs behind his back. I read Indiana Implied Consent to Joseph and he said he would take the chemical test. Joseph was transported to the Vanderburgh Co. Jail by the transport wagon. Tri-State Towing was called to tow the vehicle.

Officer Grimes, a certified chemical operator tested Joseph on Intox EC/IR-II serial number 011142. On 6/5/21 at 0452 Joseph tested 0.169 g/210L.

Joseph had a suspended driver's license. Joseph had received citations prior to this arrested for driving on suspended license.
