Officer Brasher spoke to Tennie. While talking to Tennie, Officer Brasher read Tennie Miranda Rights and she said she understood. Once at the jail, evidence was tested and weighed. Officers placed evidence into 7 evidence bags and sealed the bags. These 7 evidence bags were placed into the VCJ drop box.
