I pulled over and actived my emergency lights. Officer Brasher and I approached the male who was unsteady on his feet. I began talking to the male who was later identified as Dawon Moore. I asked Dawon what he had smoked today and he said nothing. I asked Dawon what he had drank today and he said nothing at all. While asking Dawon questions, it appeared he was trying to back away from officers. Dawon then started to walk towards me as he was tensed up. I grabbed Dawon's left arm and told him to put his hand behind his back. Officer Brasher grabbed Dawon's right arm. Dawon began to tense up and would not put his hands behind his back. Officers told Dawon to relax and were able to get him into handcuffs behind his back.

Due to Dawon's intoxicated state, I searched his pockets incident to arrest for public intoxication. While searching Dawon, I located a clear glass smoking pipe in his right pants pocket. From training and experience, I identified this as a glass pipe used to smoke methamphetamine. I located a rolled joint in Dawon's right pants pocket. I located a wadded up receipt with a green plant-like substance in Dawon's right pocket. I identified this green plant-like substance as synthetic marijuana.

Officers called for the transport wagon to transport Dawon. Dawon was transported to the Vanderburgh Co. Jail. Once at the jail, Dawon's speech was slurred and hard to understand. I tested the green plant-like substance and it tested positive for synthetic with a weight of 1.5 grams. Three evidence items were placed into evidence bags and sealed. All evidence items were placed into the VCJ drop box.
