She had previously been staying in another state for the last month to be away from him. She has pictures, videos, voicemails, and messages prior to that time going back months that show numerous times where he has battered her causing injury and made threats toward her. She stated she never called to report any of the incidents because she was afraid to put him in the system and because he was very manipulative. She is worried now since he has moved out and told her she could have the apartment that he may come back since he stills has a key. When he came yesterday with his family to get his things out nothing got physical but there were several vague threats made that made her uncomfortable. She has a couple friends that are supposed to be coming to stay with her until she can hopefully get a Protective Order. At this point she stated she understands what he was doing to her was not right and that she is willing to do whatever is necessary to file charges on him, get a protective order, and keep herself safe. There are no recent incidents within the last month but she has several pictures of injuries from months ago that show the level of violence the Offender is capable of. The listed IO is the Offenders mother. She has also left threatening messages on the Victim's phone in the last several months but has never gotten physical with her.

Upon arriving, I met with the victim. The victim advised she was driving her vehicle, a black Nissan Sentra north-bound on Garvin Street toward the intersection of Washington

Avenue. The victim advised that light for her lane of travel north-bound was green, so she proceeded into the intersection. The victim advised that the offender was traveling west-bound on Washington Avenue, disregarded the red light, and crashed into the rear right of her vehicle. The victim said after the initial crash, her vehicle spun to the right (east) and crashed into a rock wall off to the north-east of the intersection, causing damage to the center right of her vehicle.

The victim advised that she and the offender pulled off to the side of the road just north of the intersection on Garvin Street. The victim advised that she took a picture of the offender's vehicle, a silver Acura (Indiana license plate: EEA243: Expiration: 06/21/2021). The victim also photographed the offender, a black female with shoulder-length straight hair. The offender told the victim that she had to go fill up her tire and that she did not have insurance on the vehicle, so she left north-bound on Garvin Street until out of sight.
