The foil with white powder was properly bagged, sealed, labeled, and dropped into evidence at the VCCD.  The syringe with an unidentified clear liquid inside of the syringe was documented on an Officer`s body camera. The clear liquid was put through numerous field test kits; however officers were unable to determine what the liquid was. The syringe was filled with 36ml of clear liquid and weighed .3 grams.
