The officer ordered the offender to place her hands behind her back, which she took a step back and refused to comply. The officer gained control of the offender and again ordered her to place her hands behind her back, at which point the offender tensed her left arm physically making it difficult for the officer to place her in handcuffs without incident. The necessary amount of force was used to effect the arrest.</p> <p>Officers spoke with the victim who stated the incident started over a verbal relationship argument. The victim stated he tried to leave following the argument but the offender would not let him. The victim did not say if she physically prevented him or not from leaving.
