McDowell informed me that the cats must be removed to prevent to spread of disease to animals that live in/at the surrounding homes. McDowell also advised that the cats have not been vaccinated and will most likely die of their illnesses. McDowell lastly informed that she attempted to obtain the offender's information for her report prior to my arrival, but he and the involved other starting yelling at her and getting into her face. She said she decided to walk away and call EPD for assistance. I walked up to the front door of 1230 Harriet Street, knocked on the door, and made contact with the offender. I asked the offender why he was disrupting McDowell's work. He advised that McDowell was going to take all of the cats from his property and he was not happy about it. I informed him that the cats were not taken care of, all were disease-ridden, currently in a significant state of neglect, and were all suffering of deathly-ill conditions. The offender backed down and agreed with my assessment. McDowell was able to capture five cats in total; however, many more remained hidden throughout the property that she was unable to catch. McDowell informed the offender that she was going to put traps out to catch the remaining cats. I noticed one cat ran into the backyard of 1300 Harriet Street when trying to herd them. McDowell and I made contact with the home owner at 1300 Harriet Street (witness). We informed the witness we were there to see if she owned any of the cats running around the area. The witness informed she does not and they all belong to the neighbor next door (offender). The witness also advised that the offender will feed the cats, which attracts them to the area. When asked how many

cats the witness has seen over at 1230 Harriet Street, she informed that there were

approximately 30 cats living over there. McDowell requested her consent to set traps in her yard to help capture them. She agreed and McDowell informed her she would be back later to explain the details and fill out paperwork.

In terms of the conditions the cats were living in, all of them were outside; however, I noticed that one cat ran from the inside of the house. It is currently unknown if the offender has cats inside of the home and if so, how many. Using my department-issued body-worn camera, I photographed some of the key problems of the animals' living environment and outward physical appearance. I noticed there was small amounts of cat food left out on the front and back porch of the residence, but not enough to feed all of the cats. I photographed the cat kibble. I also noticed that there were two water bowls in the backyard that were filled with water, but the water contained unknown worm-like substances (possibly left over pasta noodles of some sort - but I was unable to tell completely). I also observed what appeared to be chicken in one of the bowls that had a pungent and foul odor. I photographed the water bowls. I then noticed a carpeted "cat tree" located on the back porch. The cat tree appeared to be soiled inside, smelled heavily of ammonia (consistent with cat urine), and was dirty in appearance. I photographed the cat tree. I also noticed a small plastic tote in the back yard that was crafted into a small shelter. The bottom of the shelter had towels in it that were soaking wet. It also contained large cobwebs as if it had not be attended to for awhile. I took photographs of the plastic tote shelter.

Lastly, I took photographs of the conditions of the cats. All of the cats were sneezing and many of them had some sort of bacteria/viral infection in their eyes. One of the cats was not moving. McDowell said the cat had not moved for awhile. I provided McDowell with a case number for her reference. McDowell advised that the cats would unfortunately have to be euthanized due to their poor health. McDowell informed me that she would contact EPD when she returned to set traps in order to keep the peace with the offender.
