Smith gave permission to force entry. I then called for a K-9 and other assisting officers. Once K-9 arrived on scene, I briefed him as to what I had and he also spoke with the VI to once again, reaffirm that the OF had no legal rights to the house and that she was fine with us forcing entry. Once Dep. Chamber's retrieved his K-9 and approached the door, the OF heard the dog and advised he was coming out. Officers then cuffed him and I placed him in my car, till the wagon arrived. Finally, I decided to look in his phone, where I did observe several recent messages, messages that were only hours to 48 hrs old, where the VI is angry with the OF, believing he is having an affair on her and messages where he's accusing the VI of sleeping around on him and talking to other guys. One message, the VI told the OF that he should know better, because she wants to marry him again and she still loves him. During this, one of the OF's friends drove by and he also confirmed that the OF and VI are always in an off again, on again relationship. The VI's sister arrived on scene to take care of the house and she also stated that they are always on again, off again, but that's because the OF is a great manipulator.

With the this new information, I did not feel comfortable making a custodial arrest for Residential Entry. I then called and spoke with Sgt. S. Smith. He too agreed and thought it best not to arrest, instead, file a report and send it to the DV Unit. I then released the OF and served him with a bar/ban order for this address. I advised the OF if he is caught back on this property, he would be arrested for Trespass. The OF stated he understood and walked away. I then

called records and had them put the alert on the OF.
