The victim purchased \$1,500 in gift cards and promptly gave the codes by messenger text. The victim is reluctant to believe this is not his cousin. The victim is very reluctant to believe this is a common and basic international scam.</p> <p>EPD Financial Crimes attempted to contact the victim's cousin in an effort to calm a family feud.
