She responded by rolling the windows up and locking the doors. She began to back up in the travel lane, nearly colliding with a vehicle behind her. She was told to stop and get out of the vehicle. She put the vehicle in drive and took off south on S Linwood Ave. There were cars in the roadway, and she drove up and onto the west side of the sidewalk. She drove through neighbor's yards and nearly struck children's toys in the front yard of the locations. She was told to stop multiple times. During her flight, driving through front yards, she struck and destroyed a child's bicycle, belonging to the victim Kemp. He said he did not know her.
