I, Officer R. Eagleson, was on duty fully dressed in an Evansville Police Department uniform driving fully marked Evansville Police Department vehicle 1744. I was patrolling with my partner, Officer D. Neighbors. We were dispatched to 401 Harriet Street for a welfare check of Tammie. The reporter, a representative of Brentwood in Newburgh, stated that Tammie was making statements to kill herself and others over the phone. The reporter stated she was possibly under the influence of methamphetamine and K2. When we arrived on scene, Officer Neighbors spotted Tammie walking east-bound on Michigan Street near Baker Avenue. Officer Neighbors and I drove to the intersection and located Tammie walking east-bound.

I exited my patrol vehicle and told Tammie to come speak with me. Tammie refused to speak with me and continued to walk away from us, crossing the intersection to the east. Due to having reasonable belief that Tammie was suicidal and/or homicidal, I stopped Tammie on the sidewalk just to the north of the aforementioned intersection to check her welfare. Tammie initially refused to stop, but finally did so. Tammie excitedly uttered that she had a pipe in her pants after speaking with her. Officer Farmer arrived on scene and searched Tammie after her admission. Officer Farmer located a gray metal pipe containing burnt residue in her pants. Based on our training and experience, we believed the pipe was used to ingest narcotics into the body. Tammie was also wearing a blue colored bag. Upon search incident to arrest, Officer Farmer located a small plastic baggie containing a green leafy substance. Officer Farmer also located a small black canister containing a green leafy substance. Based on our training and experience, we believed the substance was synthetic cannabinoids (K2). Officer Farmer seized the narcotics evidence, then handed it to me.

Tammie was transported to the Vanderburgh County Jail under the listed charges. At the Vanderburgh County Jail, the green leafy substance in both the plastic baggie and canister were separately tested using NARK II Synthetic Cannabinoids Reagent test kits 23A and 23B. Both field tests were positive for the presence of synthetic cannabinoids. The synthetic cannabinoids were weighed using a zeroed triple-beam scale. The synthetic cannabinoids in the plastic baggie weighed a total of two (2) grams. The synthetic cannabinoids in the black canister weighed a total of five (5) grams. The synthetic cannabinoids in the plastic baggie, canister, and the paraphernalia were properly bagged, labeled, secured, and stored
