As the male, later identified as Chad Welker, exited the home, he began to grab on the grip of the pistol that he was openly carrying, and he began to swiftly walk directly towards the Officers patrol car. Welker crossed</p> <p>Lodge, stepped off of the sidewalk, and took several steps through a grass field walking directly towards our vehicle. Welker had his hand on the pistol the entire time and continued to pull at it as he approached the police vehicle. Due to the recent ambushes on police Officers, Officers quickly maneuvered their police vehicle, and started to travel north on Lodge Avenue. Welker continued to pull on the grip of the pistol as if he was going to draw it and use it. Officers continued north on lodge and then turned back south once they had gotten a safe distance away. Officers then observed Welker still pulling at his pistol on his hip, and attempting to make entry into the west side of Faith Heritage Baptist church. Once Welker saw the police vehicle, he immediately hid behind the bush that was next to the west door he had just attempted to open. Once Officers passed Welker, he walked north past the church and then began to walk east on Conlin Avenue. Due to the fact that there was reasonable suspicion that a crime was being committed, Officers parked their marked patrol vehicle on the corner of Conlin Avenue and Lodge Avenue. Officers exited the vehicle, and gave verbal command for Welker to stop. Welker disregarded Officer`s verbal commands, and continued to run east. Once he was east of the church, he ran south out of Officers sight. Officers were able to apprehend Welker, and he was placed into handcuffs a short time later on the northeast corner of the grass field just north of Lodge Community School.</p> <p>Welker was read the Miranda Warning to which he stated understood and that he wished to speak to us. Welker originally gave Officers a fake name, and then later stated that he had a Felony warrant, which is why he ran from Officers. Welker also stated that the gun he had was a BB gun, and that he threw it in the backyard of 1415 Conlin Avenue. Officers located a black and pink pistol BB gun with no orange safety cap near the pool in the backyard of 1415 Conlin Avenue. The holster was also located in the same backyard, near the playground.</p> <p>During a search incident to arrest, Welker stated that he had "dope" in his front left pocket. Officers retrieved a small clear baggie with a white crystalline substance inside, which based upon their training and experience, they immediately recognized it as methamphetamine.
