Officer Wellen stated he used a pill identifier app on his phone and found the tablet was identified to be oxycodone-acetaminophen with a dosage weight of 5-325mg. Office Wellen said the tablet is a schedule II controlled substance. The offender stated he understood. The offender was transported to the Vanderburgh Co Confinement Center in the transport wagon.

Upon my arrival at the confinement center, I walked the offender into the intoxilyzer room where he was tested on the Intox EC/IR-II instrument. The offender failed the tested showing a BrAC of .153% per 210 liters of breath. The offender was housed on the listed charges.
