According to AP, the female offender had neglected to scan multiple items while at the self checkout. The male offender aided in helping select the stolen merchandise and was there at the checkout with the female.

There was an extensive language Spanish language barrier between myself and the offenders. The female spoke more English than the male. I played a YouTube video that read them the Miranda Warning in spanish (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Qcnar2ACQLU>). They advised they understood their rights. According to Carlos he knew that Keyli was not scanning all of the items. According to Keyli, she also knew she was not scanning all of the items.

The offenders were cited and Walmart was given a case number for their reference.

Officers were dispatched to the above listed address in reference to a theft report. Officers spoke with the reporting person by telephone and during the conversation, it was found that entry was made into the reporters vehicle but it was not damaged and nothing was stolen from within the vehicle. An incident report was completed.
