Killebrew stated that Emery pushed her three times, causing her to fall into the couch and the closet, all in front of their two year old mutual child. Killebrew stated that Emery then hit her two times with a closed fist, and then fled out the back door. I observed two scratches down the left leg of Killebrew, and she denied medical treatment on scene. The living room had items scattered everywhere as if a struggle had ensued. Killebrew stated that she and Emery had been in a romantic relationship for five years, and they have a mutual two year old child. Emery was transported to the jail via the transport wagon, and was booked in on the above charges.</p> <p>While at the jail during a search of Emery's property, Officers located a clear baggie with a yellow powder like substance inside of a pair of black jeans. The pair of black jeans was located inside the Ruler Foods bag that Emery was holding when he was taken into custody. The substance was weighed on a zeroed scale and weighed 4.2 grams. The substance was then tested utilizing the NARK II Fentanyl Reagent test kit #33, which yielded a positive result for Fentanyl. Officers then asked Emery where he got the pants from, and Emery stated that he got them from the apartment at 635 Cross Street, to which he earlier denied being at. Emery later stated at the jail that he lied, and that he did go over to the apartment. Emery admitted to arguing with her and throwing her items on the ground, but Emery stated that he never touched her.
