The victim's injury was photographed using my Body Worn camera.

It was at this time the reporter, apartment manager, observed the incident. She informed officers she directed the offender sit by the apartment complex office, but then he left the scene before officers arrived.

Officers and K9 Units were not able to locate the offender.

The victim was provided with a case number and domestic violence resources. She was also provided with information on how to obtain a protective order, to which she stated she was aware of this process. Officers stood by while the victim gathered some belongings so she could leave her apartment.
