Officers read both occupants the Miranda warning on their department-issued body-worn camera, to which they both stated they understood and wished to speak with us. I asked Karla what the pills were and she stated that they were Loritab and Valium, which she did not have a prescription for. While searching the purse, Officers also located a blue glass pipe with burnt residue, which based upon their training and experience, they immediately recognized it as drug paraphernalia that is commonly used to ingest illegal drugs. Karla stated that the pipe was hers, and everything inside of the pink bag was hers. The driver was taken to the hospital for medical clearance, and then transported to the Vanderburgh County Jail and booked on the above listed charges. The passenger was released from the scene.

While at the jail, the pills were identified using the Drugs.com pill identifier tool. There were four white pills with the imprint "RP10325", which is Acetaminophen and Oxycodone Hydrochloride, a Schedule II drug and is classified as a Narcotic. There also were three white circular pills in the clear container, with the imprint "AN627", which is Tramadol Hydrochloride, which is a narcotic, and is a schedule IV controlled substance. In the container there were four green circular pills with the imprint "MYLAN 477", which is Diazepam, which a schedule IV controlled substance. The container also had twenty-two white pills, with the imprint "M367", which is Acetaminophen and Hydrocodone, which is a Schedule II controlled substance, and is classified as a narcotic. The brown cigarello with burnt leafy substance inside, field tested positive for synthetic cannabinoids. All of the pills, the two brown cigarellos, and the blue glass pipe were all properly labeled, bagged, and dropped into evidence at the jail.
