The Rp then pulled up her security camera and it showed a red passenger car speeding west on Linwood Avenue after multiple gun shots went off. Officers were unable to see the plate on the vehicle or the exact model.

Officers located nine shell casings at the intersection of Jefferson and Linwood. Victim 2 (V2) was outside and I asked him if he saw anything.
