I, Ofc. N. Pitt, was dispatched to 912 W. Columbia St. in reference to a person with a gun. According to Central Dispatch, two black males with masks ran into the back apartment. One of the males was armed with a gun.

Upon arrival, officers located victim 1, Gregory Snyder, in apartment B. Apartment B is on the south side of 912 W. Columbia St. Involved Other, Zachary Smith, was also in the apartment with Snyder. Snyder stated he was sitting in his apartment with Blake Briscoe when they heard a knock at his door. Snyder stated that Blake opened the door and three individuals entered the apartment. Snyder described the individuals as two white males and one white female. One male was described as approximately 6'2" tall and weighed approximately 240 pounds. This individual was wearing a blue, fleece lined jacket and wearing a covid mask. Snyder stated he could see a tattoo on the right side of this individuals face. The second male was described slender and approximately 5'9" tall and weighed approximately 150 pounds. The second male was wearing a gray hoodie and was also wearing a covid mask. The female was described as approximately 5'9" tall and weighed approximately 140 pounds. Snyder stated she had blonde hair and was wearing a gray hoodie, white sock hat and covid mask. Snyder described all three were in their mid-to-late thirties.

Snyder stated the larger male demanded money from him. The slender male had a handgun and pointed it at Snyder. Snyder pulled out his wallet and handed over approximately \$470.00 in cash. The suspects also took Snyder's phone, a Samsung Galaxy 20. Snyder stated that Blake's mom had pulled up in the back alley while this was happening. Blake was able to escape the house and jumped into his mom's car, who then drove off. Once the three suspects got the money and phone, they left and walked east through the alley toward Sam's Food Mart and Second Ave.

As the suspects were leaving out of the back gate, Smith was walking through the alley to visit Snyder. Smith stated he observed a larger white male and skinny white male exit the back gate and walk east through the alley. Smith stated he said what's up to the larger male, but the larger male just looked at him. Smith stated he didn't pay too much attention to them and was unable to provide any further description.

Officers were unable to locate the supects and a report was taken. Snyder was given a case number and advised a detective would be following up.
