On scene officers observed minor redness to the female`s neck. Based on our training and experience the red marks were not consistent with the story claimed by the female and appeared to be self inflicted.</p> <p>Officers made contact with the male, who was waiting in his car down the street. The male stated that his wife was upset with him because he was going to see his daughter. The male stated that his wife dislikes her and causes issues whenever he tries to see her.
