Officers gave her verbal commands to walk back towards officers and she was taken into custody without incident.</p> <p>Once in custody, officers observed the female to have blood shot eyes and the odor of alcohol came off of her person. The driver was read Miranda, and she stated she understood her rights. The driver admitted to drinking alcohol prior to driving.
