The suspect stated he understood his rights and agreed to speak with officers. The suspect stated he and his girlfriend, the victim, got into a verbal argument. The suspect stated the argument was over an incident that occurred earlier today; the victim cursed in front of the suspect's grandparents. The suspect stated shortly after their argument, the victim left the home.

The suspect stated he attempted to let the victim's dog out but it got off the leash and ran away. The suspect then called the victim to tell her that her dog was loose. The victim searched for the dog for a few minutes before she returned home. When she got home, the two continued to argue. The suspect, who had been drinking, stated he attempted to get into his truck so he could fix the window to cool down. The suspect stated the victim attempted to stop him and accidentally broke his key off inside the door. The suspect stated he became upset and grabbed the victims arm, moved her to the side, and then went into the home. The suspect also stated he may have accidentally grabbed the victim's throat but immediately let go because he did not mean to. The suspect then stated the two went inside until officers arrived.

The victim told Officers a similar story. However, the victim stated their argument was not physical at the truck or at any point. The victim stated she attempted to stop the suspect from entering his truck because she thought was going to drive away. The victim stated the suspect only lightly pushed her out of the door way so he could shut it. The victim stated he was not violent, she did not consider that physical, and she did not want to press charges. Officers clarified about the incident at the truck and asked the victim if the suspect grabbed her throat and/or restricted her breathing at any point. The victim stated he did not grab her throat, her breathing was never obstructed, and again stated she didn't want to press charges.

Both parties were given a case number for future reference and advised how to pursue charges with the prosecutors office. The two were advised to separate for the night and told to call back if they needed officers.

vehicle, visibly having to pull herself out, as she staggered. Officers gave her verbal commands to walk back towards officers and she was taken into custody without incident.

Once in custody, officers observed the female to have blood shot eyes and the odor of alcohol came off of her person. The driver was read Miranda, and she stated she understood her rights. The driver admitted to drinking alcohol prior to driving. The driver then stated she would take field sobriety tests (SFSTs) once at VCCC. The driver's vehicle was inventoried and then towed to Tri-State Towing. The driver was searched and then transported to VCCC.

Officers administered SFSTs at VCCC. During the horizontal gaze nystagmus test, the driver showed distinct and sustained nystagmus at max deviation and had onset nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. The driver also could not follow directions on following the stimulus with her head only. Officers next gave the driver the walk and turn test.

During the walk and turn test, the driver missed every heal-to-toe step. The driver did not take the proper amount of steps (took 5) and then turned to her left and began to walk (did not fully turn around). The driver stated she was then too "fucked up" to complete the test. Officers finally gave the one legged stand test that the driver attempted for three seconds, before saying she could not complete the test. After SFSTs, the driver was read Implied Consent and she agreed to take a chemical test (certified breathalyzer).

The driver took the certified breathalyzer and blew a 0.192 grams of alcohol per 210 L of breath. The driver later admitted to drinking three quarter pints of TMJ apple post Miranda. The driver stated she drank it after leaving the 711 Tavern. It was also found the driver had never received a license through the Indiana BMV.

The driver was charged on multiple charges.
