The father stated because he is wheel chair bound he did not follow her out the door or try to stop her. The father stated he had attempted to contact his daughter's probation officer and just wanted her to return home.

In speaking with the juvenile at the Jeanette address, she said she did get into an argument with her father and told him she was going to leave. However, she also added that when she told her father she was going to leave that he repeatedly told her to go ahead and leave. The juvenile took this as permission to leave and when officers made contact with her, told officers that he just told her that to get her in trouble. The juvenile told officers she is frequently allowed to go to the address on Jeanette and added that she has been allowed to stay there overnight in multiple occasions for different durations of time.
