Reported: 12/18/2021.</p> <p>Officers were dispatched to a motor vehicle accident.</p> <p>Upon arrival, officers located the driver of vehicle 1. It was found the driver was headed south bound on N Tekoppel, when it hit a parked truck from behind. The parked vehicle was located on the west side. The driver exited the vehicle and made contact with the owner of the parked truck.</p> <p>As officers were conducting their investigation officers could smell a strong odor of alcohol coming off of the driver of vehicle 1. The driver had glossy, red eyes and could not walk in the straight line (staggered as he walked). Officers, after collecting is information (license, insurance, etc.) for the accident, asked the driver if he would take field sobriety tests (SFSTs). The male stated he would.</p> <p>Officers gave the male the instructions for the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test. Yeager had cues of intoxication during the test. As officers were about to do the vertical nystagmus portion of the test, the male began to sway so bad he stumbled backwards and almost fell to the ground. At that time it was deemed the rest of SFSTs (one leg stand/walk and turn) were not safe to complete do to the male`s level of intoxication. Officers placed the male in handcuffs. Officers called for the transport wagon.</p> <p>Once in handcuffs the male was read Miranda and Implied Consent. The male consented to the chemical test and stated he understood his rights. The male stated he took his prescription Adderall earlier (2 hours before drinking and driving). The male also stated he had a couple of drinks (three Captain Morgan and diet soda drinks). Officers asked him if he would take a portable breathalyzer test (PBT), the male consent. The male blew .222 grams per 210 liters of breath on the PBT.</p> <p>The transport wagon arrived on scene and the driver was taken to Deaconess Mid-Town for jail clearance and blood draw.
