She states that on 11/28 or 11/29, she allowed Zachary to "test-drive" the car. He later told the victim that the car was stolen. Zachary told the victim that he had the car parked, unlocked, and running near the Una Pizza on St James Blvd on 11/28 or 11/29. Zachary told the victim that a black male (the OF) then drove off with the vehicle. The OF was known to Zachary. The victim states that Zachary walked back to her house that day to inform her of the theft. She states that the suspect later answered a phone call on Zach`s phone, which had been left inside the vehicle.

Officer contacted Audobon Chrysler and Regional Acceptance to confirm the vehicle was not repossessed. Audobon said they did not repossess the car but had a record of the sale to Siniard. Officer was unable to get ahold of Regional Acceptance. The Kentucky Registration still shows Audobon Chrysler as the registered owner of the vehicle. The victim states that the car had a busted front windshield. She states that on today's date (12/6/21) a black male showed up at her house (2325 Culverson Ave) demanding to know where Zach was. The victim states that the black male threatened to shoot her house up and flashed a handgun in his waistband. She described the suspect as a younger black male with short hair. She states that she called Zach, who confirmed that the man who came to her house was most likely the known OF. The victim's brother, Justin Siniard, says that the same male harassed him down the street. He states that the male told him
